A unique and enduring partnership was formed with Australian Catholic University and the mighty Roygirls took to the field as Fitzroy-ACU for their first official game on Sunday 19 April, 2015 at Brunswick Street Oval against a well-established team from Chirnside Park.

An excited crowd of friends, family and supporters cheered our newest team on all day and a great smother, superb handballs and big tackles all met with thunderous applause.

In the end, the Roygirls only kicked a solitary point and lost that first game by 69 points against an opposition with far more experience.

None of that mattered however, as what started out as a dream – to put a Fitzroy women's team on the ground wearing the famous guernsey and singing the much loved theme song – became a reality. The dream has gone from strength to strength in the years that have followed.

A look back at the players who were judged best afield in that first game includes the names Sarah Lynas, Alexa Madden, Liz Olney and Tess Young – all of whom are still playing at the club in 2024, as indeed are a number of others from the team of 2015.

In a stellar first year, Alexa Madden was named in the best players a staggering 9 times in 12 games. What a champion of our club Lex has been since day one. The Roygirls had a wonderful inaugural year finishing a respectable fifth on the ladder with some great wins over Hallam (twice) and Melbourne University.
