Boundary umpire Required for all teams – home and way

This is a great job for someone who wants to keep their fitness up. We'll provide training, uniform and whistle.

Goal umpire Required for all teams – home and way

We'll provide the flags and the coat.

Umpire escort

For all away games, we are required to provide an umpire escort. You're to walk them out onto the ground at the start of the game, off at half time, back on after the break and at the end of the game.

Runner

This is a very important role as you'll be taking messages from the coach to players. You'll need a good level of fitness as there'll be a lot of running!

Team manager

This is an ideal job for someone who loves to organise and wants to be involved.

There is a small amount of time dealing with online requirements but the bulk of the time is on game day to make sure players and coaches have everything they need and all volunteer roles are filled. You'll also liaise with the field umpires.

You'll receive training before the season starts and support throughout the season. This job is not as daunting as it sounds, and is very rewarding.



Timekeeper

A timekeeper from each club sits together to record the start and finish times of each quarter and blow the siren to get quarters started and finished. You will also record all goals and points.

Water carrier

This is an important role in our on-field support and a great way to be involved.

Water carriers deliver water to players during the game. To be able to do this job you'll have to be able to jog at a reasonable pace and be aged over 15.

You'll receive training and a uniform will be provided each week.
