

ROLLING IN...THE ESSENTIALS!

- Pick up your wristband and car pass from Birdsville Town. You <u>CAN'T</u> get into Bashville without it.
- You must stick your vehicle sticker to the outside of your windscreen and wear your wristband at all times. Do this in Birdsville before you head off to Bashville to avoid any delays at the entry gates.
- Early Entry roll in starts at 8am on Sunday 4th or Monday 5th July (depending which option you purchased). Check your ticket and car pass to find out which day you can arrive from.
- Early entry roll in closes strictly at 6pm. If it's busy on the road or at camp entry it might take an hour or two to travel from Birdsville – make sure you arrive in plenty of time. If you get to the entry gate after 6pm you won't be allowed in.
- You will be allocated to a marked campsite with a minimum size of approximately 100sqm. The shape of each campsite will vary, but most will be around 13.5m x 6.75m. Marshals will direct you to the best available campsite when you arrive. The campsite is filled from front (closest to stage) to back.

FURTHER INFORMATION

- Our aim is to get people into camp as quickly as possible. At peak times there may be queues as you enter the site, so please be patient. We'll be doing our best to minimise wait times, and you'll be kicking back in camp before you know it.
- Just before you reach your campsite there may be a short wait as others position themselves into their sites. Please be patient during this process to help everything run efficiently and calmly.
- Your campsite will be adequate and comfortable, but please don't take more space than you need.
 Help us avoid Bashville sprawl!

FAQS

Can I roll in on a later day?

Yes, your Early Entry Pass tells you the *earliest* day you are allowed to roll in, but you can pick a later day. For example, if you have a 2 Day Early Entry Pass you can choose to roll in either Sunday, Monday or Tuesday, however if you have a 1 Day Early Entry Pass, you can only choose from Monday or Tuesday.

If we are coming in a group can we all camp together?

Yes, but you must arrive at the Bashville entry gate together. We recommend you meet in Birdsville first, and drive in convoy to the Bash site. Groups that arrive together will be allocated adjacent campsites.

Can we save a campsite for friends who are coming later?

No, space saving is not allowed because we fill the campsite from front to back as campers arrive.

I have a dog, how do I know where to camp?

Marshals will direct you to the dog friendly campsite when they see your special windscreen sticker.

Can I choose a campsite further back than the one I'm allocated?

Yes, just ask the marshals who are directing patrons to their campsites.

Can I leave the campsite in my vehicle after I'm set up?

No, vehicle movements are prohibited once you've set up in camp, for the safety and comfort of everyone. For full details, see the *Camping Overview* page on our website.

What is there to do at Bashville, for those rolling in early?
