Welcome TO THE 2021 BIG RED BASH!

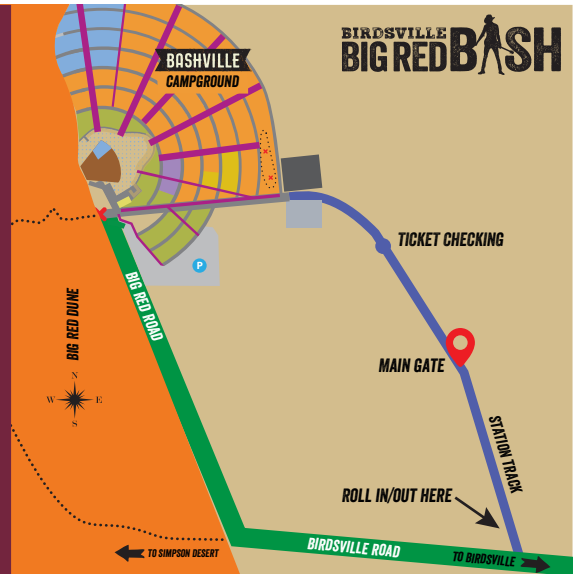
Up to 4000 vehicles will roll into Bashville in only 3 days! Moving this many people into and out of Bashville is quite a feat!

Make sure you're prepared so you don't get delayed at Bashville gates. We want to get you comfortably settled as quickly as possible and make sure that your roll out is smooth and efficient.

Of course it will take some time, but with a little patience and by following some handy hints we'll make it as easy as it can be.

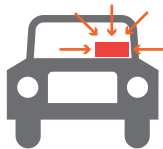

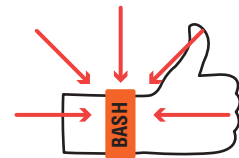


BEFORE LEAVING BIRDSVILLE

- 1 Affix vehicle stickers to passenger-side windscreen

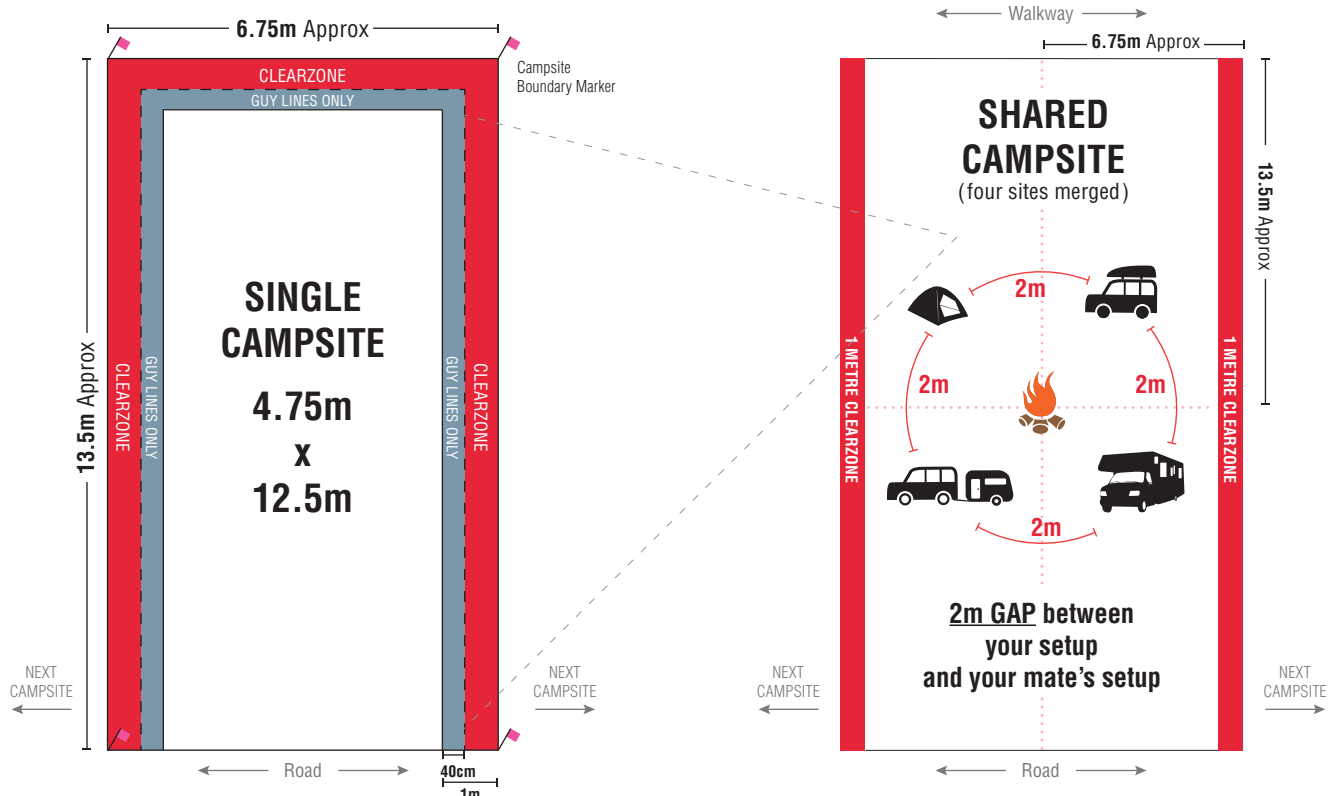


- 2 Put on your wristband

- * GROUPS will be directed to adjacent campsites.

*Only for 'Two Day Early Entry Camping Pass' holders

- * Expect delays of up to 2 hours at peak times
- * Head west on Adelaide Street for 35km
- * Headlights on
- * Drive to the conditions
- * No overtaking
- * Present your wristbands to volunteer road marshals at the gate
- * Tell marshals if you are rolling in with a group
- * GATES CLOSE 6PM SHARP

GETTING TO YOUR CAMPSITE

10

- * Stick to the Bashville speed limit. 10km/h minimises dust and keeps everyone safe
- * Our volunteer marshals will direct you to GENERAL, BIG RIG, DOG or DISABILITY camping areas
- * Campsites are filled from front to back

DURING THE BASH

- * Kick back and relax. We recommend coming prepared and parking up for the whole Bash
- * Help us maintain our proud record of zero traffic incidents in Bashville
- * If you need to move your vehicle there are limited times when you can drive to Day Parking

ROLL OUT need to know

- ☞ 2 ½ days
- ☞ More than 60 volunteer road marshals
- ☞ Over 4000 vehicles leaving Bashville
- ☞ As campers pack up they need to join the line. Make room – there's no such thing as pushing in.

BACK TO BIRDSVILLE

- * Expect delays
- * Drive to conditions
- * All services and attractions in Birdsville are open
- * Please observe road closures, police directions and signage in Birdsville
- * Headlights on
- * Don't overtake

ROLL OUT TRAFFIC GUIDE

Thursday 8th	Friday 9th	Saturday 10th
EARLY EXIT 2pm – 5pm	PEAK 7am – 2pm	OFF-PEAK 2pm Fri – 12pm Sat
Early Exit: Pass holders only. Expect some minor delays. Although passes are capped, there will still be up to 400 vehicles exiting. Passes \$15 online or at Merchandise tent, available until sold out.	Peak time: If you leave early on Friday you can bet on getting stuck behind other drivers. Waiting time to exit up to 2 hours. Please be patient. If you're not in a hurry relax and wait for the traffic to die down.	Off peak: You might experience minor delays, but can generally expect a clean run.
