SAFE OUTBACK DRIVING GUIDELINES:

1. **Plan** your driving to be off the road by sunset. It's not worth the risk of hitting roos and cows at night.
2. **Take scheduled breaks** every couple of hours – enjoy the local towns, creeks and warm hospitality of the locals.
3. **Don't overtake** in dusty conditions. Slow down and hang back out of the dust. Be patient or stop for an early break and a roadside cuppa.
4. If a **truck or road train** is coming towards you raising dust, slow down, pull over to the side of the road and wait til they pass.
5. Be aware of loose and sloped road surfaces, even on straight sections of road. **Drive slower than normal** and enjoy the outback scenery.
6. The roads leading into and out of Birdsville will be busy. Allow at least a day of buffer time for the journey out and the same back.
7. **Bookmark websites** showing outback road conditions on your route and check in before you travel. Visit www.bigredbash.com.au/outback-road-conditions for more info.

BIRDSVILLE

ACCOMODATION BEFORE / AFTER

CAMPING IN AND AROUND BIRDSVILLE

- Birdsville Caravan Park (powered & unpowered sites)
- **Free camping:** opposite Bronco Branding Yards, on right side of road to Big Red. Town Common closed due to flood.

FOLLOW MARKED SIGNAGE, campers in prohibited areas will be moved on.

SHOWERS + WATER

- **Public showers** available opposite Birdsville Visitor Centre. \$5pp CARD ONLY. Sat 2 – Tues 5 & Fri 8 – Sat 9 7am – 4.30pm (subject to demand)
- **Showers** available at Birdsville Caravan Park Wed 6 & Thur 7 ONLY. \$5pp.
- Fill up **drinking water** at the Bronco Branding Yards on Big Red Road *ONLY*, see signage. Taps at Town Common are not available due to flood. No drinking water at any other location.

MEDICAL

Bring your own medical supplies. Birdsville has limited medical facilities and no pharmacy.

No vehicle movements in camp, except on roll in and roll out days.

BASHVILLE SITE RULES

- **RUBBISH:** Collect all campsite rubbish and take it to Birdsville tip. Bins are provided in the Plaza and concert area for pedestrians only.
- **RECYCLING:** Aluminium can and PET plastic recycle bins provided in the Plaza, concert area and near toilet blocks.
- **CAMP FIRES:** No firewood collection on-site. Buy from the firewood truck (limited quantity) or BYO.
- **TOILETS:** Hygienic, odourless, composting toilets and hand sanitiser provided in the campground and concert area.
- **GREY WATER:** **You must catch all grey water** (eg. dish water) and take it back to town. Dispose of excess in collection tanks at each toilet block (limited capacity).
- **NO BLACK WATER DISPOSAL ANYWHERE ON SITE** (eg. caravan toilet cassettes) Dump points in Birdsville.
- **GENERATORS:** 8am–8pm only.
- **QUIET TIME:** Quiet camp (no music) after 10.30pm
- **ALCOHOL:** BYO is permitted. No glass.
- **NO GLASS** in concert, public or camp areas. Glass allowed in your camp kitchen only.
- **DRONES:** No unauthorised drones / aircraft. Licensed drones and a helicopter will be operating nearby.
- **DOGS:** Dogs allowed in the dog-friendly camping & concert areas and REDARC Plaza and must follow the dog attendance rules (see Big Red Bash website).
- No chainsaws, firearms or fireworks.
- No unregistered vehicles.

BIG RED DUNE CLOSURE

For safety reasons Big Red Dune will be CLOSED TO VEHICLE TRAFFIC 6am Sunday 3rd to 7am Saturday 9th July. All vehicle access to and from the desert (to the west) will be via Little Red during the closure.

ABOUT THE LOCATION

ADRIA DOWNS STATION

Adria Downs is an accredited organic property and operates to the Organic Food Chain (OFC) Standards. The Station aims to produce high quality cattle, managed within the environmentally sustainable limits of the region, with the aim of conserving natural resources for future generations.

The Big Red Bash is held on this private property with the kind permission of its owners, and we aim to return it in better condition than we find it.

Please help us respect their requests:

- Do not drive on private station roads. Stick to the main roads from Birdsville to Big Red, and Big Red to Munga-Thirri (Simpson Desert) National Park, or the Big Red Bash roads marked on the map p12.
- Collect ALL greywater, sewage, chemicals and other waste. Refer to Bashville Site Rules for more information.
- Take ALL rubbish with you and dispose at the Birdsville Rubbish Tip.

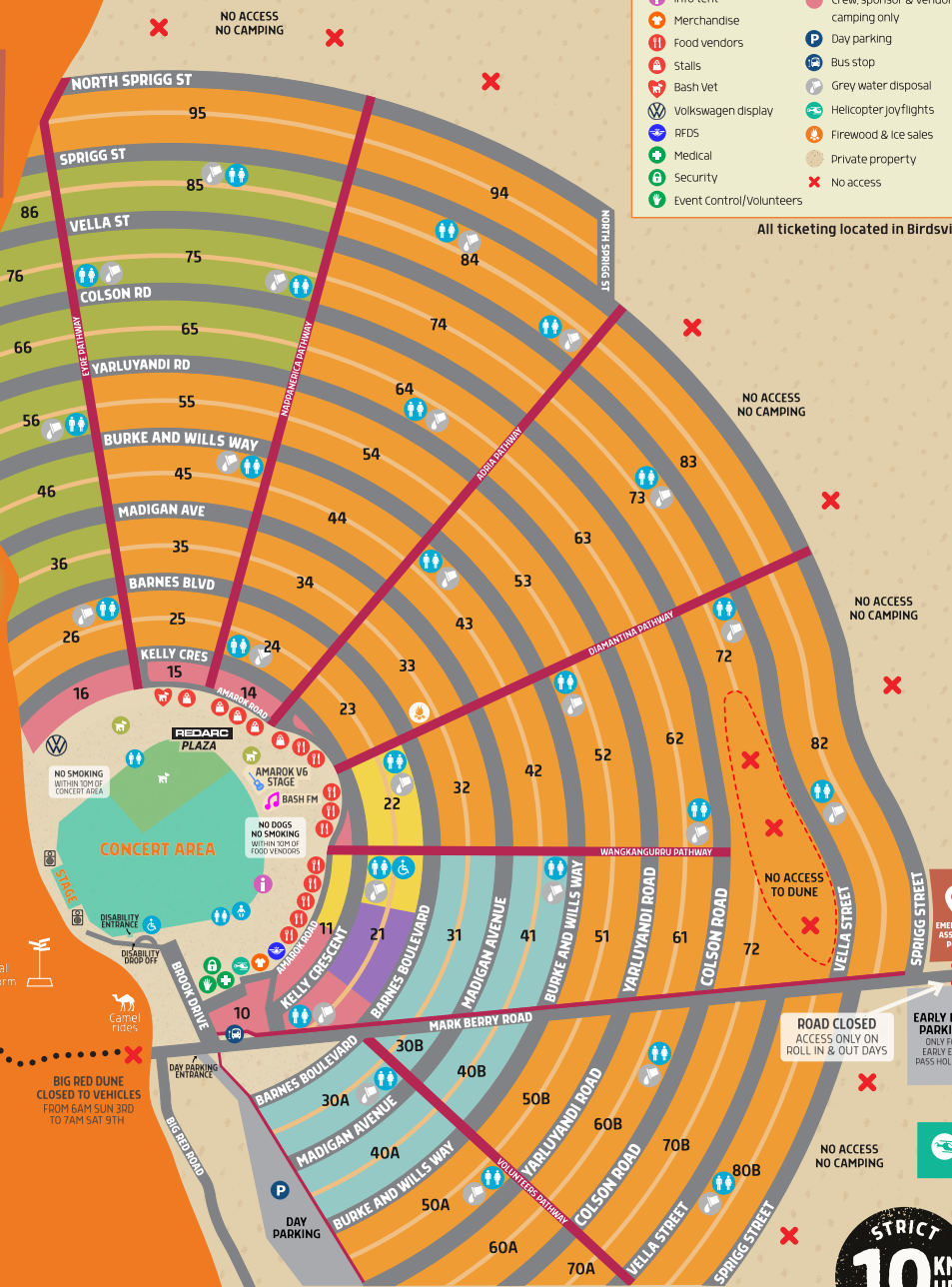

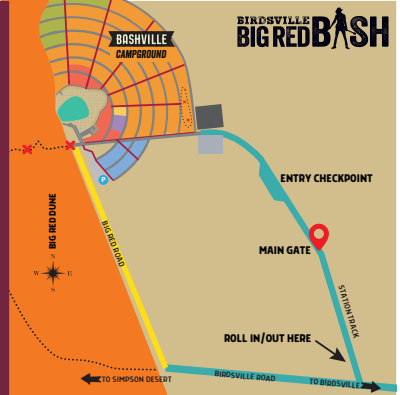
Up to 4000 vehicles will roll into Bashville on only 3 days! Moving this many people into and out of Bashville is quite a feat!

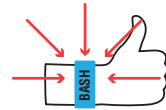


BEFORE LEAVING BIRDSVILLE

- 1 Affix vehicle stickers to passenger-side windscreen

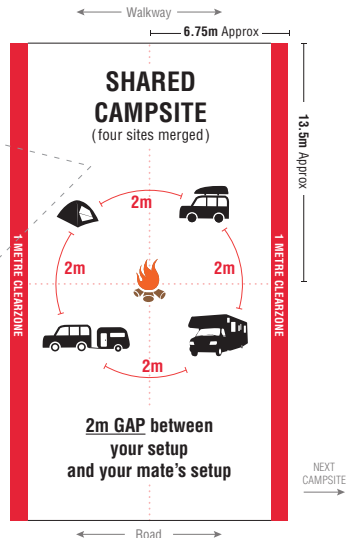
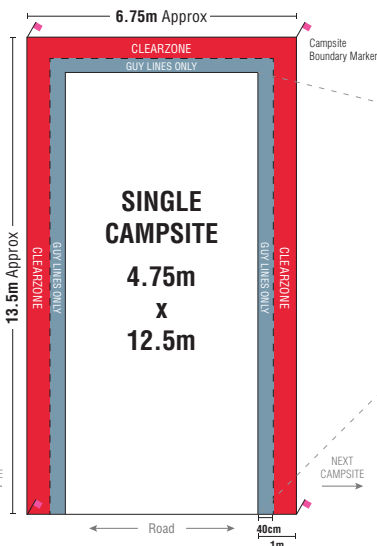


- 2 Put on your wristband

GETTING TO BASHVILLE

- Choose the right roll in time for your ticket type.



ROLL IN 8AM - 6PM DAILY

2 DAY EARLY ENTRY FROM SUN 3

1 DAY EARLY ENTRY FROM MON 4

GENERAL ENTRY TUES 5 & WED 6

- Camping with a group? Travel in convoy and arrive together.
- Head west on Adelaide Street for 35km
- Final 5km stretch of road is unsealed, suitable for all vehicle types. Take care, especially if dusty.
- Headlights on.
- No overtaking.
- Follow directions from road marshals.
- Expect delays of up to two hours at peak times.
- At the gate, tell marshals if you are rolling in with a group of two or more vehicles.

GETTING TO YOUR CAMPSITE

- Stick to the Bashville speed limit. 10km/h minimises dust and keeps everyone safe.
- Our volunteer marshals will direct you to GENERAL, BIG RIG, DOG or DISABILITY camping areas.
- Campsites are filled **from front to back**.

Need to leave the campground during the Bash?



If you have to go to town there's a transfer bus.

Come and go from town to **DAY PARKING** 7am - 7pm.

Bring your car back to camp on **Thur @ 12.30 - 1.30pm.**

EARLY EXIT Pack up and move car out of camp **Thur 7 @ 2-5pm**

GENERAL EXIT **Fri 8 @ 7am - 6pm and Sat 7am - Middy**

DRIVING BACK TO BIRDSVILLE

- Expect delays.
- Don't overtake.
- Please observe road closures, changed speed limits and police directions.

ROLL OUT TRAFFIC GUIDE

THURSDAY 7TH

PRE ROLL OUT
12.30 - 1.30pm

Return vehicle from **DAY PARKING**: Bring your car back to your camp to pack and prepare for roll out.

EARLY EXIT
2pm - 5pm

Early Exit: Pass holders only. Expect minor delays - passes are capped but there are still a significant number of vehicles exiting. Passes \$15 online or at Merch tent, until sold out.

FRIDAY 8TH

PEAK
7am - 2pm

Peak time: Leaving early on Friday you can bet on getting stuck behind other drivers. Wait time up to 2 hours. Please be patient. If you're not in a hurry wait for off-peak time.

SATURDAY 9TH

OFF-PEAK
2pm Friday - 12pm Saturday

Off peak: You might experience minor delays, but can generally expect a clean run.
