CONDITIONS AND GUIDELINES FOR CAMPING

- **CHECK IN:** Arrive after 12 noon
- **CHECK OUT:** Leave the Reserve by 10:30 am
- **LATE CHECK OUT:** \$30.00 fee_4:00pm exit
- The Reserve, including the Camping Ground is a **CONSERVATION AREA**. Vegetation and wildlife are protected. Plants are not to be damaged or pruned. No digging or moving dirt or logs unless approved by the management.
- Shoreham Beach is a **CONSERVATION AREA** of special significance. Collecting any marine species, alive or dead, is prohibited. Includes shells, anemones, seaweed, rocks etc
- Office hours are 10am to 3pm: Every weekend. From 1 November to 30 April. Off peak period hours vary. If arriving outside these times, please email or phone for entry arrangements.
- A speed limit of 10km/hour applies within the Reserve. If you are caught speeding in the Camping Area, your site will be forfeited.
- Dogs and/or other pets are not permitted in the Reserve.
- One boom-gate fob is provided per site. An extra key may be available on request. A lost boom gate fob incurs a replacement fee of \$50.00
- Sites are not powered due to long standing policy. Subsequently, generators are not to be used in The Reserve.
- Each site is limited to two cars. Boats and/or trailers are counted as one car. Cars are to be parked on booked site only. If a vehicle doesn't fit on site, it needs to be parked in allocated parking areas outside of The Reserve. (CAMPING GROUND MAP 2022/2023)
- **VISITORS CARS ARE NOT ALLOWED to PARK in the CAMPING AREA.** Allowances will be made for elderly people & others who are unable to walk into The Camping Reserve. Please refer to CAMPING GROUND MAP 2022/2023, or the sign at the Reserve entrance.
- Bicycles and scooters must not be ridden in the camping area by children.
- The boom gate is set for one vehicle per lift. If the boom gate is up, wait at the white sign until it moves back down, then approach.
- The committee is not liable for any damage to cars or vans of drivers who breach this. However, drivers will be liable for repairs to the boom gate.
- Children under 10 years of age must be accompanied by an adult when using the toilet and shower facilities.
- **STRICTLY NO FIRES** (November to May) Refer to: REGULATION 8.2.3 in 1.0_2020_Shoreham Camping Consolidated Policy. (This includes fire pits, fire pigs, open flames)
- All wastewater from vans is to be dumped in the grey water dump points (CAMPING GROUND MAP 2022/2023)
- Remove and rinse wetsuits outside amenity block in shower area provided.
- Ropes, nails or wire are not to be tied to any tree or bush in the Reserve. This includes clothesline, hammocks, tent lines etc
- **NOISE:** Please show consideration to other campers. Music and radio noise level should be confined to your site. Thank you
- **DIRTY DISHES:** Please wash on site. Hot water is available from the LAUNDRY. The laundry basin is off limits.
- Exposed flame appliances are banned on total fire ban days. At other times, use in a clear space of 3 metres and 600mm above ground.
- All garbage must be placed into plastic bags before placing into the general waste bins.
- Recycling bins for cans, glass etc. are provided. Squashing cans and boxes to make more room would be greatly appreciated.
- Tree trunks laid down as barriers or for revegetation are not to be relocated.
- The committee employs an arborist on a yearly basis to carry out risk assessment works on trees in both the Camping Area and Reserve.
- People camp in The Reserve at their own risk. The Committee does not accept liability for damage or loss of property whilst in the Reserve.
- **FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH RESERVE RULES MAY RESULT IN SITE FORFEIT, NO REFUND.**
