CONDITIONS AND GUIDELINES FOR CAMPING 2025/26



Check-In and Check-Out

• Check-In: After 12 noon.

• Check-Out: By 10:30 am.

Late Check-Out: \$35 fee for a 4:00pm exit.

Conservation Guidelines

- The Reserve and Shoreham Beach are **conservation areas**; vegetation, wildlife, and marine species are protected.
- Do not damage plants or move logs or barriers.
- Collecting marine species (alive or dead), including shells, seaweed, and rocks, is prohibited.
- Digging or trenching is restricted check with the manager.
- No dogs or pets allowed.

Office Hours

- 10am to 2pm 1 November to 30 April
- 10am to 3pm 25 December to 31 January and weekends
- Phone for after-hours entry.
- Off-Peak: Hours vary; contact manager for details.

Traffic Rules

- Speed Limit: 10 km/hour within the Reserve.
- Violating the speed limit may result in site forfeiture.

Pets

No Pets allowed.

Boom Gate and Parking

- **Boom Gate Fob**: One per site; additional fob available on request. Lost fob replacement fee: \$55.00
- Boom Gate: Drivers liable for any damage caused; one vehicle per lift.
- **Parking**: Limited to two cars per site; boats/trailers count as one car. Extra vehicles must park in designated areas outside the reserve.

• **Visitor Cars**: Prohibited except for elderly or disabled with the manager's permission.

Camping Rules

- **Power:** Sites are not powered; generators are prohibited; safe battery/solar equipment allowed.
- No Fires: November to May, including fire pits and open flames.
- Use of **exposed flame appliances** is prohibited on total fire ban days. Other times only in a cleared space of 3 metres from vegetation, tents etc and at least 60cm above ground.
- Children under 10: must be accompanied by an adult when using toilet/shower facilities.
- **Bicycles or scooters:** Children under 18 are prohibited from riding unless riding with a supervising adult.

Facilities Use

- Wastewater: Use designated grey water dump points.
- **Dishwashing**: Wash dishes on your site; hot water available in the laundry. Do not use the laundry basin.
- Wetsuits: Rinse outside the amenity block and not in the showers.

Noise and Behaviour

- Music and radio noise must be confined to your site.
- No noise after 9pm. No offensive behaviour, drunkenness, or vandalism.
- No ropes, nails, or wires to be attached to trees or bushes, including clotheslines, hammocks, tent lines etc.

Waste Management

- Place garbage in plastic bags before placing in bins.
- Use recycling bins for cans, glass, and boxes; squashing items is appreciated.

Safety and Liability

- The Reserve employs arborists for annual tree risk assessments.
- Campers and visitors enter and use the Reserve at their own risk; the Shoreham Foreshore Committee of Management and its servants and agents are not liable for any loss or damage whatsoever.

Compliance

• **Rule Violations**: May result in site forfeiture without a refund.
