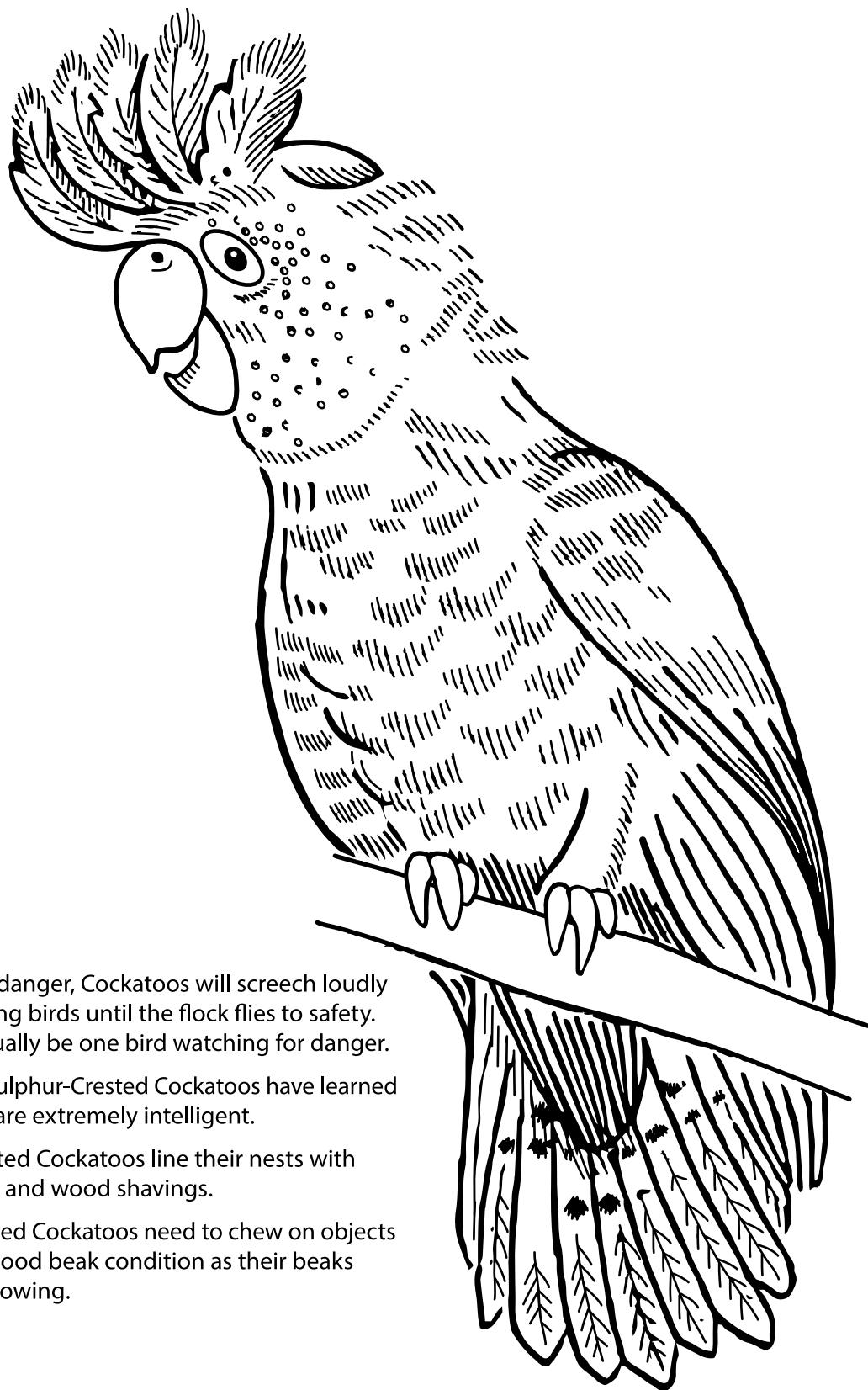


COCKATOO
