

Certificate III in Individual Support (Ageing)



Descriptor

This qualification addresses work primarily in residential facilities under direct or regular supervision within clearly defined organisation guidelines and service plans. These workers carry out activities to maintain personal care and/or other activities of living for people who are in an aged care setting and carry out activities related to an individualised plan. They report directly to a supervisor and are not responsible for other workers.

- Assistant in nursing
- Home care assistant / Personal care assistant
- Care service employees
- Community care worker / Care worker
- Residential care worker
- Support worker

Mode of delivery

This course is delivered to domestic students in face-to-face classes of 20 hours per week or mixed mode or on-the-job.

A work placement component of 120 hours is included and will be at a College-approved facility. The work component may be paid or unpaid.

Assessment and Monitoring

Assessment for this qualification is by written reports, case studies, projects, role plays, written assessments and practical assessments in a designated workplace. Monitoring will take the form of monitoring of computer-based activities and telephone/Skype consultation.

Recognition of Prior Learning

Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) is available to all students applying for this qualification. Conditions apply. RPL is the recognition of your current skills and knowledge acquired through prior learning from other training, work or life experience.

Target Groups

Students who have empathy and who wish to work in an aged care facility with the elderly, frail or infirm.
