Descriptor

This qualification addresses work in client homes and other community settings under regular supervision within clearly defined organisational guidelines and service plans. These workers carry out activities to maintain personal care and/or other activities of living for people in their own homes or in other community settings, carry out activities related to an individualised plan and report directly to a supervisor and are not responsible for other workers.

Mode of delivery

This course is delivered to domestic students in face-to-face classes of 20 hours per week or on-the-job.

Assessment for this qualification is by written reports, case studies, projects, role plays, written assessments and practical assessments in a designated workplace. Monitoring will take the form of monitoring of computer-based activities and telephone/Skype consultation.


Recognition of Prior Learning
