Advice to Members – proposed changes to VPL Rules – VPL Constitution

The Board of Victoria Police Legacy Scheme Incorporated (the association) wishes to advise members that at a Special General Meeting to be held on Tuesday the 16th July 2024 at 3 p.m. at the Victoria Police Legacy Office, Suites 4A & 4 B, 303-313 Burwood Highway, Burwood East, on three proposed changes to the Constitution. The changes relate to: -

- Under the definition of *Child or Children* (page 6) to insert the words "at the time of their death" so that the definition reads as: -
 - 'Child or Children' includes a stepchild, adopted child or child of a Spouse, any such child or children being a dependent of a Member or retired Member or resigned Member or, at the time of their death, deceased Member or deceased retired Member or deceased resigned Member or deceased Spouse of a Member.
- As part (C) the definition of *Friends of Police Legacy* (page 8) to insert the words "spouse" and to remove the age of 21 years so that the definition reads as: -
 - A Member and/or Spouse of a Member who, through death, losses a dependent child and;
- Amendment to allow for a Non-Member Director to be appointed as Chair (page 49) by inserting "and 16.1.3" which refers to the Two Directors who may be appointed to the position of Director, by, and at the discretion of the Board and who may NOT be a Member of the Association.

The following motions relating to the proposed changes will be put forward at the Special General Meeting for consideration and determination: -

- 1. The Association approves the amendments to the Rules set out in Attachment A
- 2. The Association adopt the Constitution at Attachment B; and
- 3. The Constitution be adopted with effect from the time that is approved by the Registrar (as defined in the AIR Act); and
- 4. These resolutions be recorded in the Association's minute book.
