## Our Role

Victoria Police Legacy is a charitable organisation that provides a range of services to police families across the state, who have suffered the loss of a loved one.



Should a serving or retired Police Officer or Protective Services Officer, or their spouse/partner die, Victoria Police Legacy is there to provide ongoing support to the spouse/partner and childrer

Funding is provided mainly through fortnightly tax deductible payroll contributions from serving police members. This small regular contribution assists the families of those who have served.
