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### **Support Coordination**

You will see this on your plan under the heading “Capacity Building”.

Support Coordinators help you:

- learn about your NDIS plan
- learn how to use your NDIS plan
- find services to support you
- to work through anything that goes wrong with your NDIS supports



### **Specialist Support Coordination**

You will see this on your plan under the heading “Capacity Building”.

A Specialist Support Coordinator has Allied Health or Psychological training. This means they might have training to be a counsellor, social worker, speech therapist, or something else like that.

They work with clients who have very high needs, and need a lot of support in their life.



## **Support Coordination - How do I get it? Do I have it?**

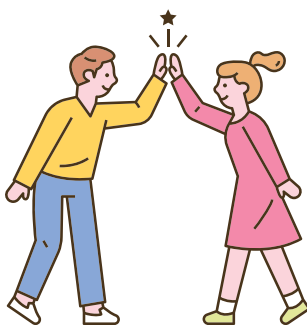
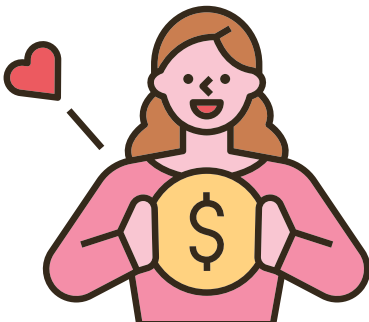
At your NDIS meeting, you can ask the Planner or LAC to give you Support Coordination.
