SELLER REPRESENTATION

Seller warrants to Buyer that Seller is the legal and true owner of the "Pet/Animal" and that Seller has the unqualified right to sell the Pet/Animal.

Furthermore, Seller warrants that the Pet/Animal is sold free and clear of any lien, security interest, mortgage or encumbrance.

Seller warrants any veterinarian fees owing to a Veterinarian Clinic or Hospital are solely responsible for payment of any fees incurred prior to the pet/animal being sold, rehomed or adopted.

WARRANTIES (tick all that applies)

The Pet/Animal is sold with no express or implied warranties or representations having been made by the Seller to Buyer other than those expressly stated above.

The purchase price of this Pet/Animal will be refunded if the Buyer furnishes the seller with a veterinary certificate indicating that the Pet/Animal is unwell or unsound and returned within 72 hours from delivery or collection. The Seller will reimburse no veterinary or shipping costs.

The Pet/Animal is healthy at the time of sale and has had immunisations (up-to-date, and not overdue) enumerated in the attached health record.

The Pet/Animal has been desexed by a Veterinarian (Desexing Certificate attached).

If at any time the Buyer is unable to keep or care for the Pet/Animal, it must be returned to the Seller.

The Pet/Animal may not be transferred or sold by the Buyer. The Buyer's understanding and acceptance of this condition is signified here by his or her initials: _____ on _____ (date).

The Buyer may not return the Pet/Animal for any reason if they are liable and/or responsible for the change in health, wellbeing or behaviour of the Pet/Animal, for example, suffering from any ailment that was not present prior to being sold (kennel cough, eye infection, bladder infection, vomiting/diarrhoea, chocking a toy/bone or has sustained an Injury due to negligence (example, walking off lead, fall from a moving vehicle), or not providing adequate supervision of children with Pet/Animal, or injuries sustained during a cat/dog fight.

The Buyer may return the Pet/Animal, in particular a dog, if it is showing aggression, resource guarding, lunging or attempting to bite, however, it is totally at the discretion of the Seller.

DESEXING AGREEMENT (tick all that applies)

The Buyer agrees to adopt this pet already desexed. The Seller agrees to supply a copy of the Desexing Certificate for the Buyer's records.

The Buyer agrees that this puppy/kitten being sold is to be spayed/neutered before 6 months of age to avoid extra registration fees, and shall not be used for breeding.

The Buyer agrees to notify the Seller when the "pet/animal" is to be booked with a Veterinarian for desexing.
