the dead!



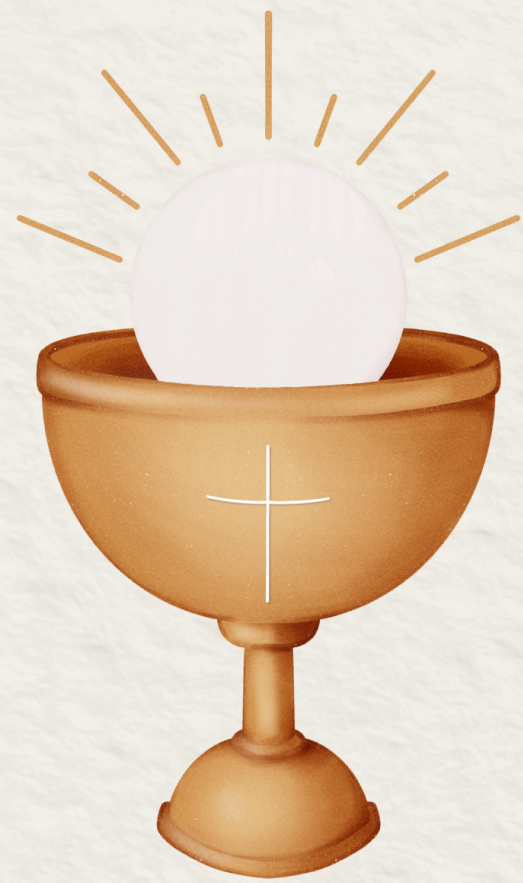
At the same time,
